

each of our members (parents, players and coaches). Instead, the KYSA took steps to simplify our Code of Conduct into something that is more positive, actionable and easy to remember. teams) will be June 22/23. The Mike Bartram Youth Soccer Tournament (for U13 to U18 house teams) will be held on the weekend of May 4/5, while the House League Playoffs (also for U13 to U18 house teams) are scheduled for the June 22/23 weekend.

The 2019 Thompson-Okanagan Youth Soccer League Playoffs are scheduled for June 22/23. Shuswap (Salmon Arm) will host the girls and Kelowna will host the boys. The league is for district select teams.
